RIVER OF LIFE DINNER

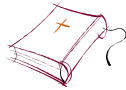

This class is open to teens through adults and meets in the Fellowship Hall. Our Bible Hour is designed so you can just "drop-in". There is no book to buy and each segment can stand completely on its own. Coffee will be on so bring your Bible and get ready to explore and grow!



All youth will meet at 4pm today to hear the presentation on "Understanding Mormonism". We will then enjoy dinner together and following dinner, we'll prepare for our Youth Worship Sunday on February 19th.



The most important event in history was the death and resurrection of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. We remember and celebrate Christ's victory over sin and death every Easter. Easter is so important to the church that we have a period of time, called Lent, just to get ready for it.

Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 22. At 7:00pm we'll have one of the most special services we do all year. It will be a service of repentance where we write down our sins and nail them to the cross. Later we take down the sins, burn them and then use them to make the mark of the cross that is traditional for worshipers to receive on Ash Wednesday.

Many people find this to be one of the most meaningful services we do all year. Please plan to join us for this celebration of the grace and forgiveness of God.

Through the Sunday, February 19th, we have set out all of the items that have been found throughout the church. Please check to see if your "treasure" is among the clothing, dishes, etc.

During Lent, we will begin the sermon series, *The Good and Beautiful God* based on the book by James Bryan Smith.
