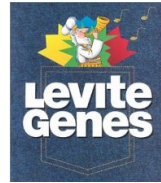

### THE NEXT GENERATION

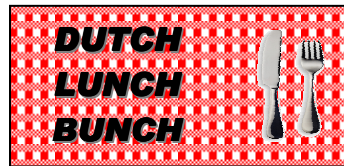
TNG will begin to work on their musical, *Levite Genes*, that will be presented in March.
