## BLOOD DRIVE

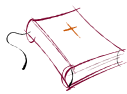

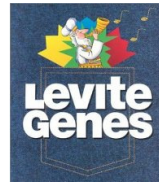


**UMYWE:** The "United Methodist Youth Week End"
