Dear Friends,

Every time I enter our sanctuary I look at our stained glass windows. I can't help it. Not only are they beautiful, but depending on how the light

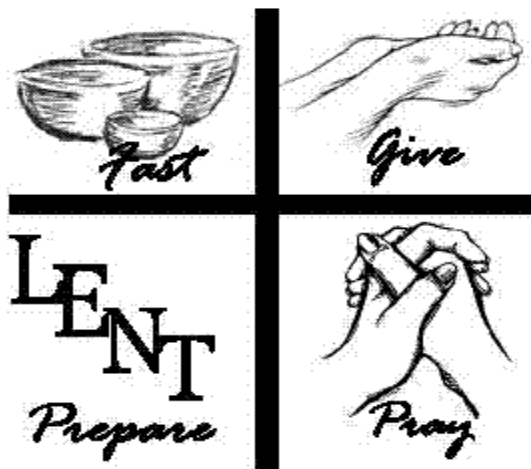
shines, they change in look and feel. I love the warmth and color they give to our worship space. The symbols in their panes communicate so much about our faith and what we believe and cherish. I know others appreciate and enjoy the windows as well.

Recently, I have received requests from several members asking if they could contribute money for the purchase of more windows. This has created a bit of a dilemma for me. On the one hand, we pastors are taught to never turn down a gift (and I would certainly like to see more windows). On the other hand, I know that before we start adding windows, we should develop an overall plan for how they will look. That is a huge and almost overwhelming task.

Our worship committee has been talking about how to develop a plan. First of all, we want to reaffirm the original instructions that guided our first windows. We want to have warm and welcoming colors. We want the art to be representational ---- that is to say, we want symbols rather than pictures of Jesus (which might limit us in how we think of our Lord). We would like to have a wide array of symbols that would speak to us about our faith.

We also wanted to open it up to you, the congregation, to give us your ideas. Are there themes you think should be represented on the windows like: salvation, resurrection, sin, hope, etc? Are there symbols of our faith that you think should be included like: the Ten Commandments, the burning bush, the towel and basin, nets, fish, etc? We are not guaranteeing that your ideas will be used, but they very well might be, so let us know. A box just outside the sanctuary, along with forms, will be made available to receive your suggestions. Pray about it first and then give us your thoughts.

WELCOMING COMMITTEE NEEDS YOUR SUPPORT:

The primary goal of the Welcoming Committee is to welcome visitors to the Eagle United Methodist Church. The committee especially likes to reach out to visitors on their first, second, and third visits to help them become acquainted with and involved in the life of the church. The Welcoming Committee also coordinates the Lunch with the Pastor to further involve visitors in the life of the church.

The Welcoming Committee is looking for volunteers to assist with several different on-going activities:

Mug Delivery, "Muggers" – We are trying something new. We would like to try and make a brief (3 min) contact with visitors within 48 hours of their first visit to our church. We are looking for volunteers to help with this effort. Volunteers would drop off a welcome mug at the visitor's house – not a walk in visit, just knock, say thank you for visiting and hand them a mug from the church. The church normally has about 1-4 visitors per Sunday. If we had several volunteers, we could break this up so that it would only be an every other Sunday commitment with only 1 or 2 brief visits.



Review Sign in Sheets – in order to achieve the time sensitive goal for the mugs, we also need volunteers to help review the sign-in sheets during each service. Reviewers would identify visitors and prepare mugs (with driving instructions) to give to our "muggers" directly after the service. We would need 1 or 2 people per service to assist with this function.

Welcome Booth - We are also looking for volunteers to help man a "Welcome Booth" (15 minutes before and 15 minutes after) each service. This would provide a friendly face where visitors could ask quick questions about the church (is there child care, Sunday School, where is the bathroom, etc).

We are in great need of volunteers to help us with all of these functions. We grow as a community by involving those who are currently a part of our church family in welcoming and offering their love to those who are new to our church community.

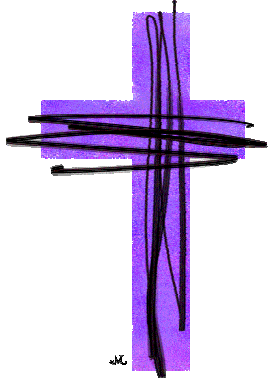

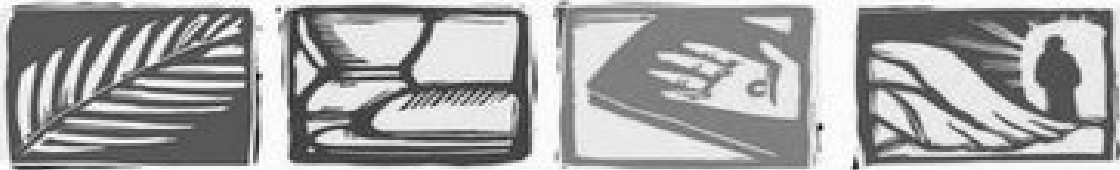
