**We continue our study for the first two weeks in February**



The most important event in history was the death and resurrection of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. We remember and celebrate Christ's victory over sin and death every Easter. Easter is so important to the church that we have a period of time, called Lent, just to get ready for it.

**Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 22. At 7:00pm** we'll have one of the most special services we do all year. It will be a service of repentance where we write down our sins and nail them to the cross. Later we take down the sins, burn them and then use them to make the mark of the cross that is traditional for worshipers to receive on Ash Wednesday.

Many people find this to be one of the most meaningful services we do all year. Please plan to join us for this celebration of the grace and forgiveness of God.

## BEINNING FEBRUARY 29TH

During Lent, we will begin the sermon series, *The Good and Beautiful God* based on the book by James Bryan Smith. Turning to the Gospels we'll put our ideas about God to the test to see if they match up with what Jesus himself reveals about his Father. Once we have discovered the truth in Scripture, we will be lead through a process of spiritual formation that includes specific activities aimed at making these new narratives real in your body and soul as well as your mind. This deep, loving and transformative series will help us discover the narratives that Jesus lived by--to know the Lord he knew and the kingdom he proclaimed--and to engage in spiritual exercises that will help you grow in the knowledge of our good and beautiful God.

Dear Friends,

The most important holiday and the most important holy day for Christians is Easter. It celebrates the most significant event of our faith and, we believe, of human history: namely the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. What Jesus accomplished on the cross and in the tomb has transformed human history and revealed the very heart of God.

The season of Lent is the name we give to the period of preparation leading up to Easter. Traditionally, remembering all that Jesus gave up for us, it has been a time of sacrifice for the followers of Christ. Remember that at its most basic level, a sacrifice is giving up something you love for something you love more. Christians have expressed their devotion to Christ by giving up something they love, be it food, chocolate, television, spending or whatever. Sacrifices remind us of what Jesus did for us and they also confirm that He is the most important thing in our lives.



Lent has also been a time for prayer and worship. Our church offers a number of special services which are among the most meaningful of any we offer during the course of the year. If you have not attended Ash Wednesday, Maundy Thursday or Good Friday services before, please consider making these services a part of your Easter experience this year. They are very special services that allow us to reflect on the life of Jesus and what He truly means to those of us who

seek to be His disciples. You will find them to be a blessing. They are also a great time to invite guests.

Finally, Lent is a time for reflection; a time to draw closer to our Lord through study and prayer. We will be doing a sermon series during Lent called "The Good and Beautiful God". It is based on a book by James Bryan Smith and it will challenge us to reexamine what we think we know about God by looking directly at the life and teachings of Jesus. Underlying this study is the belief that we often develop false ideas of who God is and how He works in our lives. But, if we look to Jesus the true nature of God will be revealed and we can come to see God for who He really is. I think this will be an excellent study and I am looking forward to preaching on it. I hope all of you will consider joining a small group this Lent.

### UMYWE:

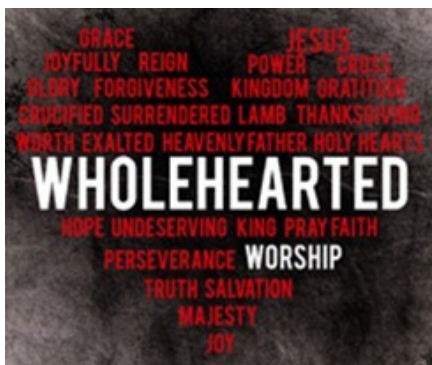
The "United Methodist Youth Week End" (UMYWE) is on Friday through Sunday, **February 3rd - 5th** in Burley, ID at the Burley UMC.

**Wednesdays from 4:00 - 5:15pm**

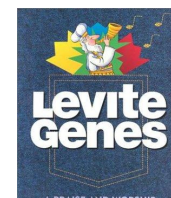
We still have room for your child! **The Next Generation: Children's Music Ministry** provides your children with opportunities to learn the joys of praising God through singing.

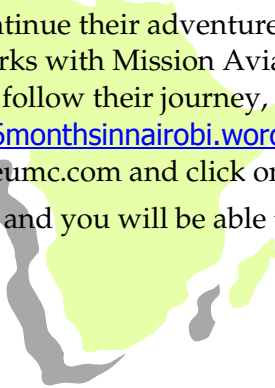

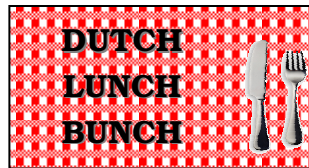
### LADIES NIGHT OUT!

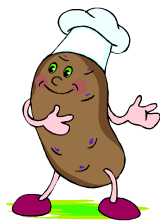
